YMCA of the Rockies – Estes Park, CO

June 9-16, 2018

Join families and individuals from our congregation for a week of hiking, horseback riding, fishing, crafting, relaxing and fun at the YMCA of the Rockies in Estes Park, Colorado. The group of 60-90 folks from ages 1 to 91 stays in a lodge with lovely mountain views and enjoys the home cooked meals provided by volunteer chefs from our church. If you don't like to camp but you love the mountains, this is the place for you.

ACCOMMODATIONS

Private rooms with private baths are comparable to a Holiday Inn. Each room sleeps a maximum of six people. There is also a female-only bunkroom, which is all bunks and sleeps eight. A large community living room and dining space with cathedral ceilings overlooks a scenic mountain range and is equipped with a playground, large deck and lovely patio. COST

- **Private room** – \$1,700 (\$1,600 if paid in full by Nov. 1), plus each participant pays a \$85 food and activity fee. A \$250 non-refundable deposit will hold your place. The remaining balance will be due as follows: \$500 due Feb. 1; \$500 due Mar. 1; \$450 due Apr. 1.
- **Female-only bunkroom spot** – \$375 (\$275 if paid in full by Nov. 1) plus the \$85 food and activity fee. A \$100 deposit will hold your spot. Total due by May 1.
- Food and activity fee due May 1.

All deposits are **non-refundable**. Additional payments are refundable only if the cancelled spot is filled by Apr. 30, 2018. Rooms will be released to other guests if the payment schedule is not kept.

ACTIVITIES

You design your day with any of the many choices:

- Children ages 3 through high school may enroll in the YMCA day camp one or more days. Cost is roughly \$27 per day. Visit www.ymcarockies.org to enroll.
- Savor a scenic drive to the Continental Divide or lace up your boots and hike through the stunning scenery.
- Enjoy the YMCA facilities near our lodge including: swimming pool, miniature golf, craft shop, library, basketball, tennis, fishing, guided hikes, archery, history and nature classes, photography classes. Horseback riding is available for \$25 per hour.
- Nearby Estes Park and surrounding towns offer golfing, antiquing, shopping, sailing, and white water rafting.
- Our two lodges are great places to sit and read, sit and visit, or most important for many folks, just sit. Wireless internet is available.

WHEN – June 9-16, 2018, arrive between 4:00-6:00 p.m. on Sat., June 9 and depart by 9:00 a.m. on Sat., June 16.

WHO – Singles, couples, and families of all ages and stages. Non-church members may sign up after Feb. 1, 2018.

A TYPICAL DAY AT CAMP

Morning: 7:00-8:00 a.m. – Breakfast is available, along with “fixin’s” for sack lunches.

Daytime: 8:00 a.m.-5:30 p.m. – Whatever you choose!

Evening: 5:30 p.m. Vespers; 6:00 p.m. Dinner; 7:00 p.m. Optional evening activity, such as a hayride, storyteller, square dance, etc.

TRANSPORTATION – On your own. Estes Park is a 12-hour drive from Kansas City.
