

Cedar Rapids Relief Trip June 3-6, 2021

The Mission Trips Team at Country Club Christian Church is excited for you to join us on a relief trip to Cedar Rapids, Iowa, in June 2021, to work with Habitat for Humanity to do repair and relief work with homes and other buildings affected by last summer's derecho wind storm.

- Schedule: We will leave at 6:00 am on Thursday, June 3rd, to work Thursday afternoon through Saturday afternoon; we will depart Cedar Rapids Sunday morning, June 6th, to return to the church early-mid afternoon. Participants must be 18 or older. Each day will include a short devotional moment and reflection circle.
- Transportation: Depending on registration, we will either rent a van or carpool for travel.
- Lodging: We are staying with a partner church in Cedar Rapids; more information TBD.
- Meals: Included in the cost will be breakfast, sack lunches, snacks, and dinner out each night.
- Cost: \$175-250 (depending on transportation costs); final price will be decided by May 20.
- Registration: To register, fill out this form and return it to Lisa Tang at lisat@cccckc.org, along with a \$50 non-refundable deposit (cash or check can be brought to the church, or you can pay online at http://bit.ly/ccccmissiontrip). Additional liability forms may be required by Habitat for Humanity. We have a twelve-person capacity for this trip, so we encourage registering soon to guarantee your spot!
