
COLUMBARIUM AND ROSE GARDEN

A columbarium is a beautiful resting place for the cremated remains (ashes) of deceased persons.



WHERE IS THE COUNTRY CLUB CHRISTIAN CHURCH COLUMBARIUM?

The columbarium is located on the west side of the George Hamilton Combs Chapel. This lovely place invites prayer and is a peaceful gathering spot for family and friends.

WHY HAVE A COLUMBARIUM AT THE CHURCH?

Historically, churches have been natural resting places for deceased members of the Christian community and their families. Church cemeteries were the usual repositories and final resting places of their deceased members. The Country Club Christian Church columbarium allows us

to provide the church's ministry of care for the remains of departed loved ones and comfort to the bereaved.

WHO MAY BE INURNED?

The columbarium is to be used exclusively for the inurnment of human remains. Inurnment is limited to persons with a relationship to Country Club Christian Church.
