



JOB DESCRIPTION CHILD CAREGIVER

DESCRIPTION:

Child Caregivers provide safe, enriching environments for children while their guardians are attending church service, Sunday School or special events and take care of their basic needs which may include napping, diaper changing, feeding and supervising play and nap times. In addition, Caregivers are expected to provide an atmosphere of assurance, demonstrated by word and actions, love of God and love for each other.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Prepare the room(s) by gathering supplies, opening the door and having the lights on before 'children arrive.
- Receive children and greet parents at drop-off and pick-up and follow check-in and out protocols.
- Engage with children at their level. Activities provided by the Children's Ministry staff
- Maintain proper hand washing protocol: after diaper changes or helping a child in the bathroom, coming in from outside, before and after handling food and/or bottles.
- Maintain the room and equipment. Consumable materials are not shared.
- Seek assistance from another caregiver as needed.
- Return rooms to original state (or better than) and follow cleaning protocols as outlined.

PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must be 16 or older.
- Some daycare / babysitting experience is preferred.
- First Aid / CPR certifications a plus

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS:

Child Caregivers need to be able to physically interact with the children, including getting down on and back up from the floor. Lifting children up to 30 pounds may be required.
